Mpox Outbreak Information for Pilots

NOTE

This bulletin is intended for informational purposes only. In all cases, please follow the guidance of your operator, regulator, and national laws.

The World Health Organization (WHO) has just determined that the upsurge of Mpox in the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) constitutes a <u>Public Health Emergency of</u> <u>International Concern (PHEIC)</u>, following the emergence and rapid spread of a new virus strain. Several outbreaks of Mpox have occurred in different countries, with different modes of transmission and different levels of risk.

At this stage, Mpox does not seem to spread easily between people in general because close contact is required.

IFALPA strongly recommends that pilots operating to the affected areas familiarize themselves with the <u>Key Facts compiled by the WHO</u>, including transmission, signs and symptoms, treatment, vaccination, self-care and prevention."

The WHO does **not** recommend any international **travel restriction** measures at this time.
